Sunday's life threatening condition

In November 2015 One World One Smile (OWOS) helped a Tanzania young man called Sunday Mwaimu aged 23 years old. He had a large tumor in his jaw which caused facial deformity and pain. In August 2014 Sunday was diagnosed with ameloblastoma at BD Clinic of Advanced Dentistry in Dar es Salaam. Following his diagnosis OWOS team coordinated a fundraising campaign for Sunday to travel to Spain to have the tumor removed.



He landed in Madrid, Spain on 25th of October 2014 for his surgery. It was on the 7th of November when the surgical team at San Francisco de Asis Hospital in Madrid, Spain removed the tumor and rebuilt Sunday's lower jaw with bone from his fibula. The surgeons performed for eleven hours to give him back his normal oral health.

Fifteen days later, Sunday was back on his feet. He returned to Tanzania on the first week of December 2014. He was fit and very happy after the removal of that tumor which was causing him a lot of pain. But after the surgery he is joyful and partially back to his normal life.

Sunday will be doing checkups at BD Clinic of Advanced Dentistry in Dar es Salaam. A second surgery is also required for placing implants in Sunday's new jaw; this surgery is expected to be done in December 2015. Many thanks to the doctors who performed the surgery, the anesthesiologists and the amazing team from San Francisco de Asis Hospital in Madrid, Spain for the great job they did to Sunday.

Rotary Medical camp

On November 16th, 2014 OWOS joined the Rotary Club of Dar es Salaam Oysterbay in their 4th annual medical camp at Kerege Primary School at Bagamoyo, located 40km north of Dar es Salaam. 2014 was the first year a dental team was included in a Rotary medical camp.



At the Camp a big variety of health services were provided out of charge to the community of Kerege. Total of 750 individuals were seen and received treatments from different specialists including ophthalmologists and gynecologists. Screening for cervical cancer and blood tests for malaria and HIV were also performed.

OWOS dental team provided services to 56 patients throughout the course of the camp and carried out 36 emergency treatment including extractions, drainage of abscesses, and diagnosis of severe advanced lesions.

The Beaujolais Fundraiser

Beaujolais celebrates the release of Beaujolais wine each year traditionally done on 21st November. The event usually attracts people who wish to celebrate wine accompanied with very special food brought in from France, such as exquisite Cheeses and Cold Cuts with more than 10 varieties to choose from.
